The school shall promote parent-teacher communication, on an on-going basis and encourage parent-teacher conferences as the need arises. Parents are also encouraged to attend and participate in school-wide functions or events (Carnivals, Thanksgiving Dinner, Coronation, Awards Day, etc.).

The school shall provide opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, parents of children with disabilities, and parents of migratory children.
